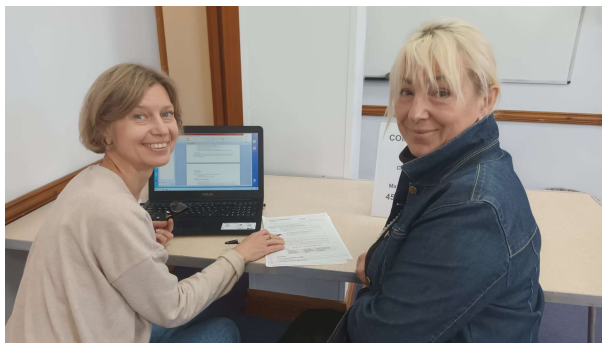

Our Committee - We continue to have a wonderful group of volunteers who attend weekly. Our accountancy student, Amy Tolley, found full time employment in September and we wish her all success. We welcome two new volunteers on board - Alice Meechan and Jenny Steele. Our volunteers have had careers in project management, teaching, aviation, business and recruitment. Their valuable time equates to c.1600 hours in 2022.

Our Clients - We currently have 62 clients on our books looking for work in many fields. **28 have found work**, 2 retired and 6 have either returned to education, moved house or have other reasons for no longer searching for work.
