We wish them all well and are very proud of how hard they worked. When a client first visits, we look through their CV and suggest changes. The edited CV is placed on job search web sites. The clients will return as many times as they wish for support with job searches and job applications. They may also wish a ‘mock interview’ session. Each step is key to building confidence.

**Our Volunteers and Committee** - As a group of 10 volunteers, we hold 6 weekly committee meetings. We are fortunate to still have our Chairman, Pete Nyman and Vice Chairman, Sharon Hall with us. .
